



Access 2.0 for English Language Learners (ELLs) is the collective name for WIDA’s summative English language proficiency assessments. It is taken annually by ELL in Kindergarten through grade 12.

The assessment measures student’s academic English language in four language domains: Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing.

The content of the assessments aligns with the five WIDA English Language Development Standards

- Social and Instructional Language
- Language of Language Arts
- Language of Mathematics
- Language of Science
- Language of Social Studies

Student’s ACCESS scores reflect proficiency levels ranging from level 1 (entering) to level 6 (reaching)

Educators use ACCESS results to make decisions about student’s English academic language and to facilitate their language development.

The testing window for ACCESS 2.0 is Jan 7 – Mar 8

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
